



City Meeting August 12th, 2021

The Adams Board of Commissioners met in regular session, at 7:00 p.m. in the Bell School Auditorium. Mayor Evans, Vice Mayor Hall, Commissioner Baird were present.

Item 1: Open with A Prayer

The meeting was called to order and Mary Mantooth lead in prayer. Evans requested all in attendance to stand for the Pledge of Allegiance.

Item 2: Minutes

Minutes of the July meeting were presented. Evans asked if there were any additions or corrections. With the no additions or corrections, the minutes were approved. Hall made a motion, Baird seconded. All in favor, none opposed.

Item 3: Financials

The financials were presented for July. Hall made a motion to approve the financials. Baird seconded the motion and the financials were approved. A rollcall was made; Baird, "Aye", Evans "Aye", and Hall "Aye". Passed 3-0.

Item 4: 2040 Growth Plan

Mayor Evans made a motion to spend \$2,000 to update the 2020 Growth Plan for the Economic Board. Baird seconded it. A roll was made; Baird "Aye", Evans "Aye", and Hall "Aye". Passed 3-0.

Item 5: New Email - Local Government

Evans made a motion to spend \$745 for a new email and Local Government secure it. Hall seconded it. A rollcall was made; Baird, "Aye", Evans, "Aye", and Hall "Aye". Passed 3-0.

Item 6: Commissioner Pay

Per our City Charter, Mayor can receive \$300 per month and each commissioner can receive \$250 per month. The pay will start Budget Year 2022-2023. Hall made a motion to approve commissioner pay and Baird seconded it. A roll call was made; Baird "Aye", Evans, "Aye", and Hall "Aye". Passed 3-0.

Fire Department – Ray Brown was not present.

Recreation Club – Brandon Farmer was not present.

Other Business:

Commissioners would like the City Recorder to reach out to Beech Construction again about fixing the concrete slab down at the ball field.

Mayor Evans presented a estimate from Brad Powell for taking the service off of the pole behind the pavilion and putting in a ground plug. The board would like to know if the box on the ground could be secured. Baird made motion to approve the estimate from Brad Powell an Evans seconded it. All in favor, none opposed.

Commissioner Baird is getting together a Fall Festival for October 29th and 30th. Face painter is \$100 per hour for 7 hours. Saturday night would be “Just Whiskey” Band playing for \$125 per band member. Two food trucks. Evans made a motion to move \$5,000 to a new line item for the Fall Festival. Hall seconded the motion. All in favor, none opposed.

There being no further business, Mayor Evans moved to adjourned. Vice Mayor Hall seconded the motion. Meeting adjourned at 7:18 pm.
