



City Meeting July 8th, 2021

The Adams Board of Commissioners met in regular session, at 7:00 p.m. in the Bell School Auditorium. Mayor Evans, Vice Mayor Hall, Commissioner Baird were present.

Item 1: Open with A Prayer

The meeting was called to order and Tyler Estep lead in prayer. Evans requested all in attendance to stand for the Pledge of Allegiance.

Item 2: Minutes

Minutes of the June meeting were presented. Evans asked if there were any additions or corrections. With the no additions or corrections, the minutes were approved. Hall made a motion, Evans seconded. All in favor, none opposed.

Item 3: Financials

The financials were presented for June. Baird made a motion to approve the financials. Hall seconded the motion and the financials were approved. A rollcall was made; Baird, "Aye", Evans "Aye", and Hall "Aye". Passed 3-0.

Item 4: Second Part of Bid 2021-005

Beech Construction was the only one to show up. Board agreed to do project #2 for the Cafertia ADA Ramp a total of \$56,477 to Beech Construction. There was a engineer present to look at the wall structure on side of building. He recommended getting this included in the bid and it was an emergency fix as the roof was caving in. Baird made a motion to award project #2 of Bid #2021-005 to Beech Construction for \$56,477 and Hall seconded it. A roll was made at the special meeting; Baird "Aye", Evans "Aye", and Hall "Aye". Passed 3-0.

Item 5: American Rescue Plan Funds

Federal government is awarding municipalities with funds for COVID-19. Funds should be used as one-time expenditures. Evans made a motion to receive the funds from ARP and use them for stormwater infrastructure. inside the City Limits. Hall seconded the reading. A rollcall was made; Baird, "Aye", Evans, "Aye", and Hall "Aye". Passed 3-0.

Item 6: Assign Funds

Bubba Watson has cut several trees for the City of Adams for years now and has not sent us a bill. I know one day he will send us one. The board believes it is a good idea to assign some funds for when the invoice is received. Hall made a motion to assign \$10,000 to assigned fund balance for trees and Evans seconded it; Baird "Aye", Evans, "Aye", and Hall "Aye". Passed 3-0.

Fire Department – Ray Brown was not present.

Recreation Club – Brandon Farmer was not present.

Other Business:

Letters have been sent to both properties owned at 5061 Bell Cross Road and 202 South Church Street for property maintenance clean up. Mayor Evans talked with both property owners and they were advised to remedy the conditions within 30 days.

2040 Comprehensive Growth Plan needs updating. The board were all in favor in participating in the update growth plan done by GRNC and the Robertson County Economic Board.

There being no further business, Mayor Evans moved to adjourned. Vice Mayor Hall seconded the motion. Meeting adjourned at 7:18 pm.
