



City Meeting October 14th 2021

The Adams Board of Commissioners met in regular session, at 7:00 p.m. in the Bell School Auditorium. Mayor Evans, Vice Mayor Hall, Commissioner Baird were present.

Item 1: Open with A Prayer

The meeting was called to order and Robert Evans lead in prayer. Evans requested all in attendance to stand for the Pledge of Allegiance.

Item 2: Minutes

Minutes of the September meeting were presented. Evans asked if there were any additions or corrections. With the no additions or corrections, the minutes were approved. Hall made a motion, Evans seconded. All in favor, none opposed.

Item 3: Financials

Item 7: Sealing Parking Lot

Bobby Green gave an estimate to seal the parking lot for \$3000. Hall gave a motion to approve. Evans seconded it. A rollcall was made; Baird, "Aye", Evans, "Aye", and Hall "Aye". Passed 3-0.

Item 8: 103 South Adams Property

Two bids were received to bush hog property. One was for \$480 and the other was for \$1350. Evans made a motion to approve the \$480. Hall seconded it. A rollcall was made; Baird, "Aye", Evans, "Aye", and Hall "Aye". Passed 3-0.

Fire Department – Ray Brown was not present. Donovan Tucker was present and had nothing to present.

Recreation Club – Brandon Farmer was not present.

Other Business:

Property Taxes for 2021 tax roll is in. City has five more parcels that will be taxed on. Appraisal is up from last year. John Poole started the audit for 2020-2021. The state recognized the city for having their annual budget balanced, passed, and sent to them by the dead line. A certificate was presented.
