

# City Meeting December 9th 2021

The Adams Board of Commissioners met in regular session, at 7:00 p.m. in the Bell School Auditorium. Mayor Evans, Vice Mayor Hall, Commissioner Baird were present.

## **Item 1: Open with A Prayer**

The meeting was called to order and Robert Evans lead in prayer. Evans requested all in attendance to stand for the Pledge of Allegiance.

#### **Item 2: Minutes**

Minutes of the November meeting were presented. Evans asked if there were any additions or corrections. With the no additions or corrections, the minutes were approved. Baird made a motion, Evans seconded. All in favor, none opposed.

#### **Item 3: Financials**

The financials were presented for November. Hall made a motion to approve the financials. Baird seconded the motion and the financials were approved. All in favor, none opposed.

# **Item 4: New Radio System – Fire Department**

Evans made a motion to assign \$40,000 for Robertson County for the new radio system the fire departments are required to have. The funds will be 50/50. General Fund will pay \$20,000 and Adams Fire Department will pay \$20,000. Hall seconded it. A rollcall was made; Baird, "Aye", Evans, "Aye", and Hall "Aye". Passed 3-0.

## **Item 5: Lease Agreements**

2022 Lease agreements were presented to the board. The current leases stand as; Cafeteria \$650, Salon \$400, Suite 201 & 203 \$275, and maintenance building office \$125. Jay Hall mentioned the City as spent a large portion of funds on improving the cafeteria. Vice Mayor would like to increase to \$750 a month for the cafeteria. Hall made a motion to increase rent for café and keep all others the same. Baird seconded it. A rollcall was made; Baird, "Aye", Evans, "Aye", and Hall "Aye".

### **Item 6: 2022 Beer Permits**

Dollar General, Adams Market, and the Corner Store beer permits were presented and signed by the Adams Commission.

Fire Department – Ray Brown was not present. Recreation Club – Brandon Farmer was not present.

There being no further business, Mayor Evans moved to adjourned. Vice Mayor Hall seconded the motion. Meeting adjourned at 7:26 pm.
