

City Meeting July 14th 2022

The Adams Board of Commissioners met in regular session, at 7:00 p.m. in the Bell School Auditorium. Mayor Evans and Vice Mayor Hall were present. Commissioner Baird was absent.

Item 1: Open with A Prayer

The meeting was called to order and Tyler Estep lead in prayer. Evans requested all in attendance to stand for the Pledge of Allegiance.

Item 2: Minutes

Minutes of the June meeting were presented. Evans asked if there were any additions or corrections. With the no additions or corrections, the minutes were approved. Hall made a motion to approve minutes. Evans seconded it. All in favor, none opposed.

Item 3: Financials

Evans made a motion to approve the reading of Resolution 2022-037. Hall seconded the motion. A roll call was made; Baird, absent, Evans "Aye", Hall "Aye". Passed 2-0-1.

Item 7: Pay Raise for Fire Department

Hall made a motion tabled this until more information was provided. Evans seconded it.

Item 8: Grand Marshall 2022

Hall made a motion tabled this until August meeting. Evans seconded it.

Item 9: Christmas Decorations

Hall made a motion tabled this until August meeting. Evans seconded it.

Recreation Club – No representative present. Update on Scott Bradley taking over the recreation club in place of Brandon Farmer. Evans made a motion to appoint Scott Bradley as president of the Adams Recreation Club League. Hall seconded the motion. All in favor, none opposed.

Fire Department – Ray Brown was not present.

Other Business: Special meeting needs to take place on Thursday July 25th at 7:00 pm for discussing the pavilion improvements and decide on a bidder.

There being no further business, Mayor Evans moved to adjourned. Vice Mayor Hall seconded. Meeting adjourned at 7:23 pm.
