How do I know I need a permit? See the below tables for some sample ideas on what requires a permit and what does not.

You need a permit!

This list is not an exhaustive list. If you are altering, changing occupancy, constructing, demolishing, enlarging, moving or repairing. Contact Adams City Hall if you have additional questions.

I am Planning to:

Paint my home

Replace Cabinets

Build a shed under 200 square feet

Build an accessory building under 200 square feet

Do Cosmetic Upgrades

Place a fence (please make sure you are off right aways for front yard – Call Adams City Hall to get right away) Also the fence can not be over 8 feet tall.

A permit is not required.

Permits should be pulled anytime structural elements are changing. Cosmetic items do not require a permit.
