

RULES & REGULATIONS FOR CITY WIDE CLEAN UP

This program is for items that are not normally hauled by you or your hired trash service

ONE PICK UP DAY FOR EACH SIDE OF HWY 41 NORTH INSIDE ADAMS (TOTAL OF 2 DAYS)

THIS YEAR IT WILL NOT BE THE SAME WEEK FOR BOTH SIDES

Bulk items such as furniture (couches, chairs, tables, mattresses), carpeting, and appliances, must be placed curbside in a neat and **orderly manner no later than 7:00 AM** on your scheduled cleanup day.

BULK WASTE COLLECTION GUIDELINES

1. Bulk waste items must be placed curbside in a neat and orderly manner within (10) feet of the street and in front of a residence that you currently occupy.
2. Bulk waste must be generated on the premises in which it is collected.
3. Bulk waste will not be collected if it is from another location/residence or if it is left on the street that doesn't have an occupied residence within the immediate area.
4. All items shall be neatly stacked in piles.
5. Any mixing of bulk items or prohibited items may result in cleanup refusal by the city or its Contractor.
6. Each type of material is collected separately due to disposal methods specified by the Robertson County Landfill.
7. Items placed in front of a vacant home or lot will not be picked up. City of Adams will be notified immediately to assist in the identification of illegal dumping.

APPLIANCES

- Appliances such as refrigerators, freezers, and air conditioners containing Freon must be discharged and tagged by a State Authorized Specialist in order to be picked up.

RUBBISH (WOOD, PLASTICS, METALS)

- The intent of this program is for residents to have the opportunity to clean out the garage, basement or closets, and get rid of old worn-out items and junk, put it out and it will be picked up.
- Remember this service is intended to help with those once-a-year cleanup projects.
- All of the normal, everyday household garbage you generate (like food waste and packaging) is not included in this program.

CONSTRUCTION AND DEMOLITION WASTE

- Construction and demolition waste will not be accepted although leftovers from a small weekend home improvement project will be taken.
- Those type of items need to be cut down to a size of no larger than 8 foot long.

PROHIBITED MATERIALS

- Materials such as fence, barbed wire, concrete, bricks, stones, batteries, tires, used oil, paint, insecticides, chemicals and hazardous waste, items normally picked up by trash service contractors, will not be collected. Yard waste, garden waste, leaves, and grass clippings will not be picked up.
