



City Meeting June 12, 2025

The Adams Board of Commissioners met in regular session, at 7:00 p.m. in the Bell School Board Room. Mayor Evans and Tyler Estep were present; Megan Baird was absent.

Open with A Prayer

The meeting was called to order and Tyler Estep led in prayer. Mayor Evans requested all in attendance to stand for the Pledge of Allegiance.

City Council May Minutes

Minutes from May were presented. Evans asked if there were any additions or corrections. With no additions or corrections, the minutes were approved. Evans made a motion. Estep seconded it. All in favor, none opposed.

Financials

The financials were presented for May. Evans asked if there were any additions or corrections. With no additions or corrections, the financials were approved. Estep made a motion to approve; Evans seconded the motion. All in favor, none opposed.

Old Business:

Ordinance 2025-066– FY 2026 Budget

Public Hearing open. No public comments. Mayor closed public hearing.

Evans made a motion to approve the second reading of Ordinance No 2025-066- FY 2026 Budget. Estep seconded the motion. Roll call was made; Evans “Aye”, Estep, “Aye”, Barid; absent. Passed 2-0-1.

New Business:

All Star Uniforms

The cost of All Star Uniforms for this fiscal year for the recreation club is \$6,490. They will be hosting five tournaments this coming weekend which shows lots of effort to continue to bring in extra revenue for the league. The City Manager Anna Redfern would like the City of Adams to sponsor the uniforms with the General Fund. We have extra money in the Line Item- Other Capital Outlay Expenditures for General Fund and would like to commit the amount that is approved out of this line item.

Evans made a motion for the City to Sponsor the whole amount of \$6,490 for All Star Uniforms using General Fund Line Item- Other Capital Outlay. Estep seconded the motion. Roll call was made; Evans “Aye”, Estep, “Aye”, Barid; absent. Passed 2-0-1.

LGIP Transfer

Evans made a motion to use the Budgeted General Fund and Transfer \$35,000 to Street LGIP to allow Street LGIP to earn more interest. Estep seconded the motion. Roll call was made; Evans “Aye”, Estep, “Aye”, Barid; absent. Passed 2-0-1.

Resolution 2025-062-911 Agreement

This is a one-year agreement made every year. This is an agreement between the county and the fire department providing the 911 dispatching services that apply to the city limits of Adams. Estep made a motion to approve the Resolution 2025-062-911 Agreement. Evans seconded the motion. Roll call was made; Evans “Aye”, Estep, “Aye”, Barid; absent. Passed 2-0-1.

Other Business:

Estep made a motion to give \$500 to Baseball and \$500 to Softball for State Tournaments. Evans seconded the motion. All in favor, none opposed.

Public Comments: None**Rec Club:**

Rec Club did receive a sponsorship from Payne Chevrolet, which includes \$500, 5 Batting Tees, a net backstop, box of lineup cards, box of scoreboard books, a box of clipboards and a Payne Chevrolet Sponsorship sign to put up. Payne Chevrolet used to sponsor Springfield but switched to Adams Rec and plans to do it again next year.

Fire Department:

Chief Tucker stated that there were some streetlights out in the City Limits.

The roof is leaking, and the rear gutter is about to fall off at the Fire Hall and Chief Tucker would like someone to come and look at it.

The protocols for type of incident have been updated for TOSHA.


The new F550 truck is getting new lights on Monday.

Klober Engineering has received the survey back from the right aways, and they are working on setting up a drainage map and calculations to determine the appropriate use of the existing drainage pipes. Mobile Communications America has done maintenance on the Tornado sirens. We do this every year to make sure everything is working correctly. Siren 1001 needs a new solar bracket arm. Siren 1002 needs a new door clamp. The Quote to fix is a total of \$2,261.25.

Evans made a motion to allow Mobile Communications America to repair Tornado Sirens 1001 & 1002 in the amount of \$2,261.25 Estep seconded the motion. All in favor, none opposed.
