City Manager Anna Redfern notified the Board that the residence of 103 S Adams had been sold and that the city would be reimbursed for the liens the city had on the property due to property cleanup.

### **3. Joint Economic Board Grant**

The city applied for a grant last year for the new gym lights, a new door, and new electrical work in the gym. The city received a check for \$10,600.
