Open with A Prayer

The meeting was called to order, and Donovan Tucker led in prayer. Vice Mayor Baird requested all in attendance to stand for the Pledge of Allegiance.

City Council May Minutes

Minutes from May were presented. Baird asked if there were any additions or corrections. With no additions or corrections, the minutes were approved. Estep made a motion to approve; Baird seconded the motion. All in favor, none opposed. Passed 2-0-1.

1. Ord No 2026-79 Budget FY 2027

Estep made a motion to approve second reading of Ord No 2026-79 Budget FY 2027. Baird seconded the motion. A roll call was made. Baird "Aye", Estep "Aye", Evans "Absent". Passed 2-0-1.

2. Ord No 2026-80 Budget Amendment FY 2026

Estep made a motion to approve second reading of Ord No 2026-80 Budget Amendment FY 2026. Baird seconded the motion. A roll call was made. Baird "Aye", Estep "Aye", Evans "Absent". Passed 2-0-1.

New Business:

1. Resolution 2026-076 Robertson County E911

Estep made a motion to approve Resolution 2026-076. Baird seconded the motion. A roll call was made. Baird "Aye", Estep "Aye", Evans "Absent". Passed 2-0-1.

2. Discussion on Roads/Streets

- a. There is a street that runs beside the Adams Cemetery. It does not belong to any landowner and is not on anyone's deed. The Adams Cemetery would like to maintain the road. The

board discussed giving the road to the Adams Cemetery. Estep made a motion for the street to be quit claimed to Adams Cemetery Association for maintenance and ownership. Baird seconded the motion. All in favor, none opposed.

- b. West Pond Street – This road dead ends behind the post office at Mr. Horace's property. The pavement stops there. In the past, the road went all the way to South Adams Street. The city does not plan on paving the road to connect to South Adams Street. All the parcels have access to public roads currently. There is a strip next to a parcel (105 South Adams Street) that is not being used or maintained. This strip of land is not paved. The board discussed quit claiming the small portion on the south side and east side of the parcel to the current landowner at 105 South Adams Street. The portion is approximately 0.175 acres of land. Estep made a motion to quit claiming the land of West Pond Street to property owner, Jarrett Reed. Baird seconded the motion. All in favor, none opposed.
